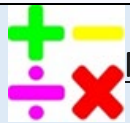


Title: Let it grow

Addition & Subtraction: Measure (Money)

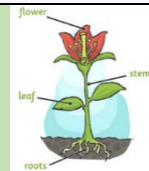
Multiplication & Division: Practical context of measures

This term the children will be using a core text as a stimulus for writing. The text 'The boy who grew dragons', will be shared through our class reading sessions, building on our reading skills of inference, clarification and retrieval. The book will also be used as a stimulus for writing the following genres - Fantasy and instruction texts with some grammar focus on conjunctions, prepositional phrases, expanded noun phrases and apostrophe for contraction.



Science:

Children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. They will also explore and learn about pollination and seed dispersal. Children will recognise that environments can change and can sometimes pose danger to living things



Spanish

This term, children will be exploring the music and dance of flamenco.

They will describe the colours and flags of some Spanish speaking countries.

They will explore key facts about Mexico, which includes life of a Mexican family and their typical food..

Children will learn how to develop their skills in striking and fielding across a range of sporting activities.

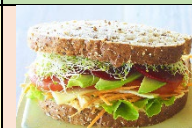


Children will understand the different activities, we can do to improve our health-related fitness -Boxercise circuits.
