Force for positive change: Children will write list poems about kindness. This will be sent to an adoption centre. Links to Matilda as she was adopted by Miss Honey.

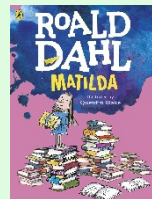

Maths



Children will continue with Arithmetic sessions, focusing on number and the four operations. Children will also be looking at statistics, fractions, geometry, and time. They will also continue to develop and consolidate their understanding of interpreting and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. The will add and subtract fractions with the same denominators within a whole.

English



This term the children will be using a core text as a stimulus for writing. The text 'Matilda' will be shared through our class reading sessions, building on our reading skills of inference, clarification, and retrieval. The books will also be used as a stimulus for writing for the following genres: A persuasive letter (Non-fiction) and a flashback story (fiction) with some grammar focus.

Science: Forces and magnets



Children will learn that when two magnets are close, they create pushing or pulling forces on one another. Children will also investigate how magnets can make objects move on different surfaces as well discover if magnetic forces attract from a distance.



History: Ancient Egypt

Children will be learning about Ancient Egypt, investigating and interpreting the past as well as putting key historical events in chronological order. Children will also understand the way of life for people at that time. In addition to this, children will be visiting the British museum to get first-hand experience of artefacts as tombs, shabtis and Sarcophagi.



PHSE: Changing Me



This term the children understand that babies grow in their mother's uterus, know and identify the parts of the body including private parts and learn acceptable and unacceptable touch.

Physical Education:

Athletics



During the summer term pupils will be focusing on athletics. They will learn to use a variety of equipment with greater control and co-ordination and learn to vary speeds in running to suit different purposes. Children will also understand the importance of suppleness and strength.

DT

Ancient Egypt -Sarcophagus



Children will be planning, designing, constructing, and evaluating their own 3d pneumatic sarcophagus. They will understand that a pneumatic system is a series of mechanism that uses compressed air to create movement.

Music



Children will explore the purpose of music in Ancient Egyptian times. They will compare compositions on similar theme, sing an ensemble and perform an instrument with control.

RE: Christianity



Children will learn about the events and celebrations that happen in churches. This includes; baptism and holy communion. They will also learn how churches support Christians with their prayer lives.

Spanish



Children will explore key facts about Mexico including their traditional clothing, food, and music.

Computing



Children will understand how to program using scratch. Children will be able to create and explain how a sprite moves in all four directions.
