Maths Multiplication & Division In maths this term, children will be learning how to multiply two-digit numbers by one digit number using formal written methods. They will solve missing number problems as well as write and calculate mathematical statements. In addition to these, they will be learning about Geometry (3d shapes) and how to add and subtract problems involving money.	<b>English</b> : This term, children will be writing a mystery story and a non - chronological report based on 'The Great Storm' and stone age era. Some of the grammar skills they will be using include: expanded noun phrases, present tense, adverbials, prepositional phrases and subordination.	History: Stone Age to Iron Age This term, the children will begin to look at the Stone Age, leading to the Iron Age. They will create a timeline and focus on Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods and begin to look at the advancement of tools & inventions over time.	Science: Rocks This term, the children will identify, learn about, and compare different types of rocks and their properties by gathering and recording them. Additionally, they will learn about different types of soils by observing them. They will also plan and conduct a fair test to determine how fossils are formed.
PHSE: Celebrating Differences Children will learn about families, that they are all different and that sometimes they fall out with each other. The children will also talk about techniques to calm themselves down and discuss a technique called 'solve it together.' The children will also revisit the topic of bullying and talk about being a witness (bystander).
