Communication and Language

Linking to our learning journey, we will be learning songs such as 'Row, row your Boat, The Wheels on the Bus, The Train Song and Ten Little Aeroplanes'. The children will role play a journey taken on a train. They will take on roles of a train driver, conductor and passengers deciding on different destinations to visit. They will practise using full sentences and develop the skills of taking turns in a conversation.



Personal, Social-Emotional Development

For this half term we will be looking at the topic 'Healthy Me.' The children will be learning about various parts of the body, and the importance of being physically active. They will gain an understanding why sleep and exercise are important. They will understand the importance of washing their hands before they eat and after they go to the toilet.



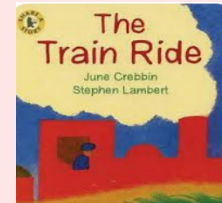
Physical Development

Our focus will be developing the children's fine motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, confidently, and safely. They will be developing their spatial awareness through a range of outdoor games and move expressively to music. The children will continue dancing with scarves making large movements with their arms whilst dancing.



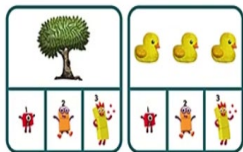
Literacy

Linking to our learning journey, we will be reading story books such as the 'The Train Ride' and 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. The children will understand newly introduced vocabulary, and they will develop phonological awareness that includes rhythm and repeated phrases. They will create their own stories about a class journey using their own ideas.



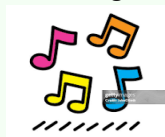
Maths

In Maths this term, the children will compare the lengths of different forms of transport and use shapes to create shape pictures. They will sing and perform number songs such as: 'Five Little Aeroplanes' and 'Zoom, zoom we're going to the Moon'. In Maths, the children will be recognising and sequencing numbers from 1-5 and will match the correct numeral to sets of 5.



Expressive Art and Design

Linking to one of our focus story books this term 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', the children will design a cave for a bear using a variety of materials. This term, we will explore seasonal changes through art such as observational paintings and drawing of spring flowers and trees. The children will create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent different forms of transport. In Music, the children will recognise the tunes of familiar songs and learn to sing a new song and perform the actions on cue.



Understanding the World

This term, we will explore the similarities between trains from the past and present, drawing from the children's own experiences and from the story book. The children will discuss and share photographs of momentous events that has taken place in their lives and share their experiences with the class. Spring is a wonderful time to learn about flowers and plants. As a class, we will observe and talk about the different flowers seen around Springtime, we will plant bulbs in our garden, take care of them, and watch them grow.
