We are pleased to announce that on **Friday 2nd May**, we will be holding our second **Hispanic Culture Day** at Kingfisher Hall Academy, where we celebrate the language and culture of Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries.

On this day, our children will enjoy a range of class-based and out-of-class activities to mark the occasion. Traditional dance, cultural food sessions and craft activities such as making maracas, piñatas and mosaics will be on offer.

Children **will not wear uniform** on this day: instead, we are asking them to come in wearing the **flag colours** of one of the Spanish-speaking countries. They are as follows:

Reception:	Spain – red and yellow	
Year 1:	Equatorial Guinea – green, white, red and blue	
Year 2:	Bolivia – red, yellow and green	
Year 3:	Mexico – red, white and green	
Year 4:	Peru – red and white	
Year 5:	Costa Rica – blue, white and red	
Year 6:	Chile – blue, white and red	

There will also be a **special Spanish-inspired menu** on the day prepared by our catering team.
